Self Catering, meal vouchers can be included to nearby diners and cafes.

Types of rooms:

University style single and twin rooms with private use of a shared bathroom.

Airport Pick-Up:

If you have booked an airport transfer, you will be met at one of the three major local airports (JFK, LaGuardia, or Newark) by a representative from our airport pick-up services. After you collect your baggage from Baggage Claim and/or pass through Customs, go to the arrival waiting gallery. This is the last area BEFORE the exit of the airport building where passengers meet the people who come to pick them up. Your driver will be waiting for you INSIDE the arrival waiting gallery. Look for someone holding up a sign with your name on it and the EC Logo.

If your first flight into the U.S. is delayed or your flight number is changed, you must call the airport pick-up service directly:

If you arrive at the airport and you cannot find your driver, you should also call the number above. If your flight is delayed or canceled, you must call to reschedule at least two hours before your originally scheduled pick-up time. Otherwise, you will have to pay for a second transfer or take a taxi.

The Amsterdam is located on the Upper West Side of New York within walking distance of Lincoln Center and Central Park. Description of local area:

The 92nd Street Y Residence is a world renowned community center located on the Upper East Side in one of Manhattan's best neighborhoods just three blocks from Central Park, Museum Mile and numerous other treasures. From here, residents can easily explore New York's renowned museums, including the Metropolitan Museum of Art and the Guggenheim, spend time in Central Park, enjoy nearby cafés and restaurants and venture into other intriguing neighborhoods using subway and bus lines, conveniently located within walking distance. Students staying at the residence will find themselves within easy reach of local restaurants, banks, pharmacies and grocery stores. There is a supermarket across the street from the Y, as well as quite a few others in the neighborhood. The Upper East Side is known for its variety of restaurants and fast-food eateries and many of them will deliver to the Residence.

Description of rooms:

92nd Street Y Residence offers rooms which include:

- standard size bed, desk and chair
- dresser and a closet which locks
- an individually-controlled air conditioning unit
- bed linen, pillow, blanket and bedspread are supplied - students should bring their own towels.
- Wi-Fi throughout the building
- communal bathroom facilities with the following ratios - 1 shower per 7 students and 1 toilet per 11 students
- housekeeping is done once a week and bed linens are changed (students must be present to open their room for housekeeping staff in order for their room to be cleaned).

Residence amenities:

- laundry rooms are available throughout the residence. The cost is \$1.00 per machine.
- 24-hour building security
- fully equipped kitchen on each floor
- complimentary gym and pool membership
- mailboxes can be provided upon request
- 10% off discount at CafeSol eatery located in building
- free admission to many of the Y's concerts and lectures



Journey to School:

Walk five blocks South (4 minutes) to the 86th Street Subway Station, going Downtown. From the 86th Street Subway Station, take the 4 or 5 train 1 stop or the 6 train 3 stops to 59th St./Lexington Ave (10 minutes). Stay inside the station, and follow the signs to the N R W trains. Take the N, R or W train 4 stops to Times Square - 42nd St (10 minutes). Exit the station on either 40th and Broadway or 42nd and Broadway and walk 1 block to 41st and Broadway. EC New York is located at 1450 Broadway, 14th Floor.

Airport Pick-Up:

If you have booked an airport transfer, you will be met at one of the three major local airports (JFK, LaGuardia, or Newark) by a representative from our airport pick-up services. After you collect your baggage from Baggage Claim and/or pass through Customs, go to the arrival waiting gallery. JFK

AirTrain/Public Transport:

- 1) Take the Jamaica Station/Sutphin Line to Jamaica Station/Sutphin
- 2) Transfer to the E train headed toward Manhattan and get off at Lexington Ave/53rd Street station.
- 3) Transfer to the Uptown 6 train.
- 4) Take the 6 train to 86th St.
- 5) Exit the station and walk 5 blocks north on Lexington to 91st Street.
- 6) 92Y will be on your right at 1395 Lexington.

Express Bus:

- 1) Take the "New York Airport Service" express bus from JFK Airport to Grand Central.
- 2) Take the 6 train headed Uptown to 86th St..
- 3) Exit the station and walk 5 blocks north on Lexington to 91st Street.
- 4) 92Y will be on your right at 1395 Lexington.

Newark

AirTrain/Public Transport:

- 1) Take the Air Train from Newark heading to Newark Airport Station.
- 2) Transfer to New Jersey Transit - Northeast Corridor Line heading to New York City/Penn Station.
- 3) Get off at New York/Penn Station (last stop).
- 4) Transfer to the E train headed toward Jamaica and get off at Lexington Ave/53rd Street station.

- 5) Transfer to the Uptown 6 train.
- 6) Take the 6 train to 86th St.
- 7) Exit the station at 86th street and walk 5 blocks north on Lexington to 91st Street.
- 8) 92Y will be on your right at 1395 Lexington.

LaGuardia

Public Transport:

- 1) Take the M60 Bus from LaGuardia Airport Station heading to Morningside Heights, Manhattan.
- 2) Get off at East 125th street and Lexington Avenue (approx. 30min).
- 3) Enter the subway station and take the 6 train heading Downtown/Brooklyn Bridge.
- 4) Get off at 96th street.
- 5) Exit the station and walk 4 blocks south on Lexington Avenue to 92nd street.
- 6) 92Y will be on your left at 1395 Lexington.

Arrival procedures for students:

When you arrive at 92Y, please tell the guards that you are checking-in to the 92Y de Hirsch Residence on the 8th floor. They will point you to the elevators straight ahead. You will then have to do some paperwork before you receive your key.

Note:

- Accommodation arrival and departure day: **Sunday**
- Smoking is NOT permitted anywhere in the building
- A refundable damage deposit of \$150 will be collected upon check in. This will be returned during check out.
- Student age restrictions:
 - students booking a single room – any age
 - students booking a twin room – maximum 28 years (if you are coming alone)
 - students booking a twin room with a friend – any age is ok if you share the room together

AirTrain/Public Transport:

- 1) Take the Jamaica Station/Sutphin Line to Jamaica Station/Sutphin
- 2) Transfer to the E train headed toward Manhattan and get off at Times Square 42 street.
- 3) Transfer to the Uptown 1 train.
- 4) Take the 1 train to 86th St.
- 5) Start out going South on Broadway towards W 85th St
- 6) Turn left onto W 85th St 1.7 Arrive at 207 W 85TH St, Manhattan

Express Bus:

- 1) Take the "New York Airport Service" express bus from JFK Airport to Grand Central.
- 2) Take the S(Shuttle) train to Times Square.
- 3) Transfer to the 1 train Uptown.
- 4) Start out going South on Broadway towards W 85th St
- 5) Turn left onto W 85th St 1.7 Arrive at 207 W 85TH St, Manhattan

Newark

AirTrain/Public Transport:

- 1) Take the Air Train from Newark heading to Newark Airport Station.
- 2) Transfer to New Jersey Transit - Northeast Corridor Line heading to New York City/Penn Station.

- 3) Get off at New York/Penn Station (last stop).
- 4) Transfer to the Uptown 1
- 6) Take the 6 train to 86th St.
- 4) Take the 1 train to 86th St.
- 5) Start out going South on Broadway towards W 85th St
- 6) Turn left onto W 85th St 1.7 Arrive at 207 W 85TH St, Manhattan

LaGuardia

Public Transport:

- 1) Take the M60 Bus from LaGuardia Airport Station heading to Morningside Heights, Manhattan.
- 2) Get off at Broadway and West 116th Street
- 3) Enter the subway station and take the 1 train heading Downtown/South Ferry.
- 4) Get off at 86th street.
- 5) Start out going South on Broadway towards W 85th St
- 6) Turn left onto W 85th St 1.7 Arrive at 207 W 85TH St, Manhattan

Arrival procedures for students:

When you arrive at the Amsterdam, please give your first and last name to the front desk and tell them you are checking in. They will give you a key and show you to your room.

Note:

- No smoking is permitted in the residence- smoking is designated outside
- No alcohol permitted in the building, regardless of age
- The residence accepts students under 18 as long as they are accompanied by a group leader

Description of local area:

The New Yorker Residence is located in the famous Herald Square area, within walking distance of Times Square, Broadway and Off-Broadway Theatres, Madison Square Garden, Macy's, and the Empire State Building. Students staying at The New Yorker will find themselves within easy reach of local restaurants, banks, pharmacies and grocery stores. Students enjoy convenient access to six subway lines and unbeatable proximity to Penn Railway Station (Amtrak, NJ Transit, Long Island Rail Road) and the Port Authority Bus Terminal.

Description of residence:

The New Yorker Residence offers fully-furnished single or twin en-suite rooms with a TV, DVD player, high-speed internet and refrigerator. These fully-furnished rooms are a great choice for busy students on the go. The residence features computer labs, lounges, a laundry room and a gym facility. Linen will be provided but students should bring their own towels. Students are responsible for maintaining their own rooms, cleaning products can be purchased inexpensively nearby. The building staff cleans the common areas (hallways, lounges, kitchens) daily.

Residence amenities:

- 24-hour security
- Air conditioning
- Key-card entrance to residences and rooms
- Laundry facilities in building (Approximate cost - \$2 to wash in regular sized washer, \$3.50 in large washer and \$0.25 for 8 minutes of drying time in dryers.)

Journey to School:

The easiest way to get to school is to walk. The residence is 1 subway stop or an 8 minute walk from the school. Students can purchase a monthly MetroCard of \$81.00 (prices may vary).

AirTrain:

- 1) Take the Jamaica Station/Sutphin Line to Jamaica Station/Sutphin
- 2) Transfer to the E train headed toward Manhattan and get off at Penn Station/34th St.
- 3) Leave the station from the 8th Ave. Exit, and walk north toward 35th St. The New Yorker will be on the west side of 8th Ave. between 34th St. and 35th St.

Express Bus:

- 1) Take the Express bus from JFK Airport to Penn Station.
- 2) Leave the station from the 8th Ave. Exit, and walk north toward 35th St. The New Yorker will be on the west side of 8th Ave. between 34th St. and 35th St.

Arrival procedures for students:

When you arrive at the New Yorker, please give your first and last name and tell the security guard by the elevators that you are checking in.

The security guard should then direct you to the student housing office on the 17th floor or give you a temporary key.

Notes:

- No smoking is permitted in the residence - designated smoking outside
- No alcohol permitted in the building, regardless of age
- Unlimited free local phone service available for all students
- Minimum age accepted at the residence - 17 years with written permission from parent
